Ready for Reading seeks to empower all ages of the Rwinkwavu community through literacy, technology and life skills, enhancing academic, social, cultural and economic opportunities for both personal and community growth and enrichment.

Overall Responsibilities:

Reading Riders Staff is essential part of Ready for Reading's Open Library and Out Reach Programs. A reading Rider personal is responsible to ensure the reading is becoming joyful both at the Ready for Reading Center and outside the center through a structured storytelling, Read Aloud and other library Activities organized by both library and Out-Reach Programs.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Rider out to local school, communities and Hospital to read with children
2. Conduct Read Aloud and storytelling sessions and other library Activities in conjunction with Librarians team at Rwinkwavu Community Library and in the community.
3. Mentor Young Readers and act as role model to ensure the reading joy progress are achieved.
4. Engage the young reader in story writing to make sure the future generation will read the story from local writers.
5. Support any identified struggling readers and aim to help them become supper readers.

Required Qualifications and Skills

1. Minimum of A2 Diploma
2. Passionate about Reading and interacting with children
3. Fluent in both Kinyarwanda and English
4. Knowledge of riding a bike is a must
5. Knowledge of French is an added value
6. Male candidates are encouraged to apply to balance gender with existing team.
